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ETHOS POLICY

The ethos statement of Kenneth Copeland Ministries is derived from our Statement of faith, our Mission and our core values as a Ministry.

What we believe?

Our Statement of Faith

1. We believe in one God – Father, Son and Holy Spirit, Creator of all things.
2. We believe the Lord Jesus Christ, the only begotten Son of God, was conceived of the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, crucified, died, was buried, resurrected, ascended into heaven, and is now seated at the right hand of God the Father and is true God and true man.
3. We believe the Bible in its entirety to be the inspired Word of God and the infallible rule of faith and conduct.
4. We believe in the resurrection of the dead, the eternal happiness of the saved and the eternal punishment of the lost.
5. We believe in the personal salvation of believers through the shed blood of Jesus Christ.
6. We believe in sanctification through the Word of God and by the Holy Spirit, and we believe in personal holiness, purity of heart and life.
7. We believe in divine healing, through faith in the name of Jesus Christ, and that healing is included in the redemption.
8. We believe in water baptism, in the Baptism in the Holy Spirit as distinct from the new birth, in speaking with tongues as the Spirit of God gives utterance (Acts 2:4), in the gifts of the Spirit and the evidence of the fruit of the Spirit. We believe that all of these are available to believers.
9. We believe in the Christian's hope – the soon coming, personal return of the Lord Jesus Christ.
10. We believe in evangelism and missionary work in accordance with the Christian commission (Matthew 28:19)

- We do not borrow money as a ministry, and we are debt free owing no man anything except love. (*Romans 13:8*) (5)
- We are quick to respond to the teaching of the Word by making the appropriate changes in our lives. (*James 1:22*) (6)
- God's Word is the final authority on all things, we always agree with the Word because God and his Word are one and the same. (*John 1:1*) (7)
- We believe everything in the Bible and so we order our conduct in line with the Word (*2 Timothy 3:16-17*) (8).
- We do not put pressure on people to donate we put pressure on the Word because it will not break. (*Matthew 24:25*; (9) *Isaiah 40:8*;(10) *1 Peter 1:23*(11)

2. We live by Faith.

At KCM this means that.....

- We speak words of faith, (*Romans 10:8-9*) (12), (*2 Corinthians 4:13*) (13) words that minister grace to the hearer (*Ephesians 4:29*) (14) and that agree with the Word.
- In all that we do, we are very deliberate and thoughtful about the words that we speak knowing that death and life are in the power of the tongue. (*Proverbs 15:4*) (15) (*18:21*) (16) (*21:23*) (17)
- We believe that our faith is the victory that allows us to withstand and overcome every storm in life. (*1 John 5:4*) (18)
- We develop our faith by putting the Word of God first place because we believe that "faith comes by hearing and hearing by the Word of God." (*Romans 10:17*) (19)
- We walk by faith not by sight (*2 Corinthians 5:7*) (20) in all that we do. (*Hebrews 11:6*) (21)
- We intentionally develop our faith by regularly listening to faith teaching. (*Romans 10:17*) (22)
- We call things that are not as though they already exist. (*Romans 4:17*) (23), (*Mark 11:23*) (24)
- We stand on the Word in faith for divine healing (*Isaiah 53:5*) (25); *Psalms 103:2-3* (26). And prosperity in our lives when we take hold of the promises of God (*2 Corinthians 9:8*) (27); *3 John 1:2* (28) in this lifetime. (*Luke 18:29-30*) (29)

3. We walk in love.

At KCM this means that.....

- We stay on our "love walk" with one another by choosing to demonstrate the love of God to one another as God has commanded us. (*John 15: 9-17*) (30), (*1John 4:7-9,11,20,21*) (31)
- We are quick to forgive one another. (*Ephesians 4:1-3*) (32), (*Matthew 18:21-22*) (33)
- We do not make judgements about other people or one another. (*Matthew 7:1-2*) (34)
- We are quick to repent before the Lord and apologise to one another when we get things wrong. (*1John 1:9*) (35)
- We do not tolerate strife, that is quarrelling, fighting or contention or critical and negative behaviour from one another. (*Proverbs 10:12*) (36)
- We love people (*1 Peter 2:17*) (37) we are not rude, prideful, or easily offended, choosing to prefer others at every opportunity. (*1 Corinthians 13:4-8*) (38)
- We endeavour to be obedient to God's word by staying in unity (*Numbers 11:1*) (39) as a team and by avoiding murmuring and complaining. (*Psalms 133:1-3*) (40)
- We aim to resolve issues quickly, to cooperate with one another and to be constructive in our relationships according to (*Matthew 18:15-17*) (41).

4. We are led by the Holy Spirit

At KCM this means that.....

- We acknowledge the presence of the Holy Spirit in all we do because it is the spirit that gives life and apart from Him, we can do nothing. (*John: 6:63*) (42)
- We discern the leading of the Holy Spirit knowing that His leading will always be consistent with the Word. (*1John 5:7*) (43)
- We practice the presence of the Holy Spirit in prayer times by listening and waiting to hear what He will speak to us (*Habakkuk 2:1*) (44)
- We are led by the Holy Spirit in our conduct and the fruits of the spirit, love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control (*Galatians 5:22-23*) (45) which reveals to others the Holy Spirit in us.
- We are continually filled with the Holy Spirit (*Acts 2:4*) (46)
- We are spirit led in prayer and so we intentionally pray in tongues listening for the Holy Spirit to bring light and revelation to our minds. (*1 Corinthians 14:2*) (47), (*Mark 16:16-17*) (48)

5. We pray about everything.

At KCM this means that.....

- We pray regularly at our staff chapels, management meetings, team meetings and other occasions when the opportunity arises. (*1 Thessalonians 5:17*) (49)
- We pray regularly for one another, our colleagues around the world and all our Partners and friends. (*Philippians 4:6*) (50)
- We pray regularly for the needs of each other and our Partners and friends knowing that we receive from the Lord when we pray. (*Mark 11:24*) (51)
- It is our practice to pray in tongues (*1 Corinthians 14:2*) (52), speaking the heavenly language to God and we operate in the gifts of the Spirit.
- We agree in faith with God's Word for our Partners and friends and stand in agreement with them in prayer. (*Matthew 18:19-20*) (53), (*Mark 11:24*) (54)
- We pray in faith over every seed sown into the ministry.

6. We protect the anointing.

At KCM this means that.....

- We acknowledge and value the anointings and callings on each team member. (*1 John 2:20*) (55) (*1 John 2:27*) (56)
- We do not charge for any ministry and so all KCM events are free of charge to everyone who attends. (*Mark 4:14*) (57)
- The Believers Voice of Victory magazine is always sown as a free resource to everyone who requests it. (*Mark 4:14*) (58)
- We don't recruit Partners; we expect the Holy Spirit to lead people to Partner with the works of the ministry.
- We never put pressure on or manipulate our Partners and friends to give into the work of the ministry. (*Proverbs 10:22*) (59)
- We never sell or advertise products and other resources during a meeting we wait until after a speaker has finished speaking and ministering.
- We honour God with thankful hearts, and we are thankful in all things and for all that God he has done. (*1 Thessalonians 5:18*) (60) (*Revelation 4:9-11*) (61)

7. We honour God.

At KCM this means that.....

- We make the quality decision to live our lives as vessels of honour. (*2 Timothy 2:21*) (62) and we watch over and guard our hearts. (*Matthew 15:7-9*) (63)
- We are tithers and sowers, and we honour God with all that we have and the first fruits of all our increase.-(*Proverbs 3:9-10*) (64) (*Deuteronomy 26:10*) (65) (*Malachi 3:10*) (66)
- We honour every minister and their ministry with the full measure of respect due the calling upon his or her life. (*Romans 10:15*) (67)
- We honour each other in conversation, and we listen when people are speaking, we take an interest in what they are saying to us. (*Romans 12:10*) (68)
- We honour elders and those in positions of authority over us by submitting to the authority of the leadership in the Ministry and by accepting and supporting the decisions that they have made. (*Hebrews 13:17*) (69)
- We honour our leadership (*1 Peter 2:17*) (70) by doing what they have asked us to do quickly and by serving them with a good attitude. (*Colossians 3:22-25*) (71)
- We honour God in our appearance, and so we are not shabby, unkempt, or inappropriate in our dress or personal presentation.
- We honour each other in the work environment by keeping our desks, communal spaces, and the rest rooms clean and tidy.
- We act with integrity, and we keep our word. (*Numbers 23:19*) (72) (*Psalms 89:34*) (73)

How we act as Christians at KCM

Christian Conduct

As a result of our Mission supported by our Core values and Statement of Faith the following practices are part of our everyday activity at KCM:

- We pray regularly at our staff chapels, management meetings, team meetings and other occasions when the need arises.
- We pray regularly for one another, our colleagues around the world and all our Partners and Friends.
- It is our practice to pray in tongues (*1 Corinthians 14:2*) (*74*), speaking the heavenly language to God and we operate in the gifts of the Spirit.
- We regularly take communion in remembrance of the body and shed blood of our Lord Jesus Christ.
- We regularly watch the Believers' Voice of Victory broadcast and other teaching from Kenneth and Gloria Copeland as a staff.
- We seek the guidance and inspiration of the Holy Spirit.
- We commit all that we do as an act of service and worship of the Lord Jesus Christ.
- As a natural part of our daily working lives, we talk about what the Lord is saying to us, the testimony of prayers that have been answered, how He has blessed us and revelation knowledge that we have gained from spending time in his Word.
- We aim to be an example of Jesus and to show the love of Christ by living victorious lives and by being a blessing to all those who come in contact with this Ministry.

We also expect team members:

- to regularly attend a church or Christian fellowship, whose teaching and practice is in agreement with KCM's biblical basis.
- to be seeking to have a sound knowledge of the Bible, be applying that knowledge in their daily life and promoting the application of it in the lives of those around them. ®
- to similarly uphold the Bible's ethical teaching, for example on the sanctity of life from conception and on sexual ethics – including the need for celibacy outside marriage or fidelity within marriage (*Genesis 2:24*) (*75*); (*Hebrews 13:4*) (*76*)
- to adhere to and agree with the Biblical view of marriage as being between one man and one woman (*Matthew 19:4-6*) (*77*); (*Ephesians 5:30-31*) (*78*)
- to have a sound Christian prayer life and consistently read the Bible.
- to fully agree with the KCM mission, vision, statement of faith and code of honour so that it underpins all work in the Ministry.

As this is the context of our work it is therefore an occupational requirement for all roles at KCM to be held by a born-again spirit filled Christians who are committed to Jesus Christ. This commitment must be consistent with our ethos, core values and statement of faith and code of honour in every respect. Our ethos is the motivation for our work at Kenneth Copeland Ministries and our personal commitment to Jesus Christ is at the centre of all that we do.

Appendix 2

Statement of Faith

The programme and activities of the Charity shall be based upon and at all times shall be consistent with the following beliefs and Statement of Faith:

The Scriptures Inspired

The Scriptures, both the Old and New Testaments, are verbally inspired of God and are the revelation of God to man, the infallible, authoritative rule of faith and conduct.

(2 Tim. 3:15-17; 1 Thess. 2:13; 2 Peter 1:21)

The One True God

The one true God has revealed Himself as the eternally self-existent "I AM", the Creator of heaven and earth and the Redeemer of mankind. He has further revealed Himself as embodying the principles of relationship and association As Father, Son and Holy Ghost. (Deut. 6:4, Isa. 43:10-11; Matt. 28:19 -20; Luke 3:22)

The Deity of the Lord Jesus Christ

The Lord Jesus Christ is the eternal Son of God. The Scriptures declare:

- A. His virgin birth (Matt. 1:23; Luke 1:31, 35)
- B. His sinless life (Heb. 7:24-28; 1 Peter 2:22)
- C. His miracles (Acts 2:22, 10:38)
- D. His substitutionary work on the cross (1 Cor.15:34; 2 Cor. 5:21)
- E. His bodily resurrection from the dead (Matt. 28:6; Luke 24:39; 1 Cor.15:4)
- F. His exaltation to the right hand of God (Acts 1:9; Acts 2:31-33; Phil. 2:9-11; Heb. 1-3)

The Fall of Man

Man was created good and upright; for God said "Let us make man in our image, after our likeness." However, man by voluntary transgression fell and thereby incurred not only physical death but also spiritual death, which is separation from God (Gen. 1:26 -27, Gen 2:17; Gen 2:17, Gen 3:6, Rom. 5:12-21).

The Salvation of Man

(A) Conditions of Salvation

Salvation is received through repentance towards God and faith towards the Lord Jesus Christ. By the washing of regeneration and renewing of the Holy Spirit, being justified through faith, man becomes an heir of God according to the hope of eternal life (Luke 24:27; John 3:3, Rom. 10:8-17; Eph. 2:5-13; Titus 2:11, Titus 3:3-7)

(B) The Evidence of Salvation

The inward evidence of Salvation is the direct witness of the Spirit (Rom. 8:14-19).

The outgoing evidence to all men is a life of righteousness and true holiness (Eph. 4:24; Col 3:1-17 Titus 2:11-14).

The Ordinances of the Church

(A) Baptism in Water

The ordinance of baptism by immersion is commanded in the Scriptures. All who repent and believe of Christ as Saviour and Lord are to be baptised. Thus, they declare to the world that they have died with Christ and that they also have been raised with Him to walk in newness of life. The baptism by immersion in water shall be administered to all those who have repented of their sins and who have believed on the Lord Jesus Christ to the saving of their souls. (Matt. 28:19; Mark 16:1; Acts 10:47-48; Rom. 6:3-6; Col 2:12)

(B) The Holy Communion

The Lord's Supper, consisting of the elements – bread and the fruit of the vine – is the symbol expressing our sharing the divine nature of our Lord Jesus Christ (1 Cor 10:16-17; 2 Peter 1:4); a memorial of His Suffering and death (1 Cor. 11:23-27); and shall be observed regularly by all believers “until the kingdom of God comes” as enjoined with the scriptures. (Luke 22:17-20)

The Baptism in the Holy Spirit

All believers are entitled to and should ardently expect and earnestly seek the promise of the Father, the baptism in the Holy Spirit and fire, according to the command of our Lord Jesus Christ. This was the normal experience of all in the early Christian Church. With it comes the endowment of power for life and service, the bestowment of the gifts and their uses in the work of the ministry (Luke 24:49; Acts 1:4-8; 1 Cor. 12:1-31). This experience is distinct from and subsequent to the experience of the new birth (Acts 8:12-17; Acts 10:44-46; Acts 11:14-16; Acts 15:7-9). With the baptism in the Holy Spirit comes such experiences as an overflowing fullness of the Holy Spirit (John 7:3-39; Acts 4:8), a deepened reverence for God (Acts 2:43; Acts 5:11; Hebrews 12:28) an intensified consecration to God and dedication to His Work (Acts 2:42; Acts 5:12-13) and a more active love for Jesus Christ, for His Word and for the lost (Mark 16:20).

The Evidence of the Baptism in the Holy Spirit

The baptism of believers in the Holy Spirit is witnessed by the initial physical sign of speaking with other tongues as the Spirit of God gives them utterance (Acts 2:4). The gift of tongues (1 Cor. 12:4-10, 28) which is a manifestation of the Holy Spirit and given as the Holy Spirit wills.

Sanctification

Sanctification is an act of separation from that which is evil, and of dedication unto God (Rom. 12:12; 1 Thess. 5:23, Heb. 13:12). The Scriptures teach a life of “holiness without which no man shall see the Lord”. (Heb. 12:14). By the power of the Holy Spirit, we are able to obey the command “Be ye holy, for I am holy” (1 Peter 1:15-16).

Sanctification is realised in the believer by recognising his identification with Jesus Christ in His death and resurrection and by faith reckoning daily upon the fact of that union, and by offering every faculty continually to the dominion of the Holy Spirit (Rom. 6:1-14; Rom 8:1-14; Gal. 2:20 Phil. 2:12-13, 13:1 Peter 1:3-9)

The Church

The Church is the Body of Christ, the habitation of God through the Holy Spirit with divine appointments for the fulfilment of her grand commission. Each believer, born of the Spirit is an integral part of the General Assembly and Church of the First-born, which are written in heaven (Eph. 1:22-23; Eph 2:19 -22, Heb. 12:22-24).

The Ministry

A divinely called and scripturally ordained ministry has been provided by our Lord for a two-fold purpose:

- (1) The evangelisation of the world, and
- (2) The edifying of the Body of Christ (Mark 16:15-20, Eph. 4:11-16).

Divine Healing

Divine Healing is an integral part of the gospel. Deliverance from sickness is provided for in the precious sacrifice of our Lord Jesus Christ and is the privilege of all believers (Is. 53:4-5; Matt 8:16-17; James 5:14-16; 1 Peter 2-24)

Marriage

We adhere to and agree with the Biblical view of marriage as being between one man and one woman (Gen 2:24; Matt 19:4-6; Mark 10:6-9; Eph 5:30-31)

The Blessed Hope

The second coming of Jesus Christ includes the rapture of the saints which is one blessed hope, followed by the visible return of Jesus Christ with His saints to reign on the earth for one thousand years (Zech. 14:4-5; Matt. 24:27; Matt 24:30; Rev. 1:7; Rev 19:11-14, Rev 20:16). This millennial reign will bring salvation of nation of Israel (Ezek. 37:21- 28; Zeph. 3:19-20; Rom. 11-26 - 27) and the establishment of universal peace (Isa. 11:6-9, Psa. 72: 3-8; Micah 4:3- 4).

The Final Judgement

There will be a final judgement in which the wicked dead will be raised and judged according to their works. Whosoever is not found written in the Book of Life, together with the devil and his angels, the beast and the false prophet, will be consigned to everlasting punishment in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone, which is the second death (Matt. 9:43-48; Rev 20:11-15; 20:11-15; Rev 21:8).

The New Heavens and the New Earth

“We, according to His promise, look for new heavens and a new earth, wherein dwelleth righteousness” (2 Peter 3:13)
