

THE POWER OF THE SOUND OF FAITH

Day 1: The Sound of Faith That Changes the World

Can praise and worship change the atmosphere around you? On this episode of *Believer's Voice of Victory*, Kenneth Copeland and Phil Driscoll discuss how faith-filled words, music and praise release spiritual power and inspire victory. Discover how God has used faith and obedience to begin and grow ministries with worldwide impact. Watch this episode and learn how your voice can become the sound of faith.

Introduction

Kenneth Copeland welcomes Grammy Award-winning musician and minister Phil Driscoll, to discuss the spiritual power of sound, praise and Faith-filled words.

Study It

- I. God created the universe through the sound of His WORD.
 - Early in ministry, The LORD spoke to Brother Copeland and said, "I want you to preach this gospel from the top of the world to the bottom and all the way around the middle."
 - That instruction launched Kenneth Copeland Ministries as an international ministry.
 - Brother Copeland recalled conducting the first worldwide Communion service through innovative satellite technology.
 - More than one million believers around the world participated.
 - Phil Driscoll explained this was one of the first major examples of intercommunication among believers of like Faith.
- II. Brother Copeland once ministered in a synagogue where the rabbi allowed him to use his study and library.
 - There he discovered a Hebrew study on Genesis 1:1.
 - The Hebrew word for *God* is *Elohim* which is plural, referring to God the Father, Jesus The WORD and the Holy Spirit.
 - "And God said, Let there be light: and there was light" (Genesis 1:3).
 - God's spoken WORD is still expanding throughout the universe.
 - Sound is the carrying force of God's power.
- III. Lucifer attempted to corrupt the sound God created.
 - Isaiah 14 reveals Lucifer's rebellion against God.
 - Ezekiel 28 describes Lucifer's musical design.
 - Phil taught that every form of music was built into Lucifer except the trumpet.

- The trumpet is heaven's royal sound.
 - Music contains melody, harmony and rhythm.
 - When satan tempted Eve in the Garden, he used sound, beauty and deception.
 - "Now the serpent was more subtle than any beast of the field" (Genesis 3:1).
 - The enemy still attempts to stop the sound of Faith because if he can stop the sound, he can stop the growth of a believer.
- IV. Believers are designed to release the sound of praise.
- Phil Driscoll shared: "I'm not a trumpet player—I am a trumpet."
 - The trumpet only amplifies the sound already inside the musician.
 - In the same way, believers are not merely praisers—they are praise.
 - God created mankind in His image as speaking spirits.
 - "So God created man in His own image" (Genesis 1:27).
 - God spoke Creation into existence.
 - Jesus taught believers to imitate the Father.
 - Faith must contain The WORD of God to release power.
 - Some churches have noise, but without The WORD there is no spiritual force behind the sound.
 - Faith-filled praise releases victory and changes the atmosphere.

Make It Personal

Your words matter. The sounds coming from your mouth shape your atmosphere every day. Begin filling your speech with praise, thanksgiving and The WORD of God. Choose to speak life, Faith and victory instead of fear and doubt.

Pray this prayer:

Father, I thank You for creating me in Your image as a speaking spirit. I choose to release words of Faith, praise and victory. Help me use my voice to glorify You and strengthen others. Let the sound of Faith come boldly from my life every day. In Jesus' Name. Amen.

Day 2: Faith Must Be Released

Are you activating or silencing the sound of faith? On this episode of *Believer's Voice of Victory*, Kenneth Copeland and Phil Driscoll share why faith must be spoken and released through praise and declaration. Phil's powerful testimony of redemption and deliverance will encourage you to trust God no matter how impossible things may seem. Tune in today and discover how the sound of faith can propel you toward victory.

Study It

- I. Faith becomes powerful when it is released.
 - Brother Copeland shared the story of how the *Believer's Voice of Victory* broadcast received its name.
 - Faith is not silent. Faith must be spoken and released.
 - "So then Faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by The WORD of God" (Romans 10:17).
 - Phil Driscoll taught that reality is not shaped only by what you know, but by what you release.
 - Hebrews 11:3 teaches that the worlds were framed by The WORD of God.
 - "Through Faith we understand that the worlds were framed by The WORD of God" (Hebrews 11:3).
 - God said, "Light be," and creation responded.
 - Believers must release the power of God through Faith-filled words.

- II. Religion without relationship produces no power.
 - Phil Driscoll shared his testimony of growing up in a minister's home.
 - His father built 15 churches.
 - Phil attempted to live on his parents' Faith instead of developing his own relationship with God.
 - He compared it to trying to ride on someone else's airplane—outside on the wing.
 - Although he achieved musical success and recorded professionally, he drifted far from God.
 - While attending a church service, the presence of God overwhelmed him.
 - Phil heard The LORD speak, *Son, this is why I gave you the ability to play.*
 - Shortly afterward, he faced false criminal accusations connected to others in the music industry.
 - Out of 99 defendants, all were imprisoned or died, but Phil was acquitted.
 - God delivered him and restored his purpose.
 - Phil declared: "God is more good than bad is bad."

- III. Praise engages the power of God like a spiritual autopilot.
 - Brother Copeland compared praise and obedience to engaging the autopilot system in an airplane.

- A flight management system is preprogrammed to take the aircraft to its destination.
- God has already prepared His plan for believers.
 - Faith and praise connect believers to that heavenly direction.
- Brother Copeland said, "Praise is the big gun of Faith."
 - "Praise Him according to His excellent greatness" (Psalm 150:2).
- Praise propels believers toward victory.
- Worship follows praise and ushers believers into God's presence.
- Phil shared how worship music combined with scripture creates a flow of Faith and reverence.

Make It Personal

Faith was never designed to stay hidden in your heart. Release your Faith through praise, thanksgiving and speaking God's promises aloud. Even when circumstances seem impossible, keep declaring God's WORD.

Write down one scripture promise you will begin speaking over your life. (Hint: There are many but you could start with Philippians 4:13).

Day 3: Strong In The LORD and Armed for Battle

Are you prepared for the spiritual battles you face every day? On this episode of *Believer's Voice of Victory*, Kenneth Copeland and Phil Driscoll teach how believers can stand strong in faith and use spiritual authority to overcome opposition. Through Scripture and personal insight, they encourage viewers to fight fear with bold praise and confidence in God's WORD. Watch now and strengthen your personal sound of faith for every battle ahead.

Study It

- I. Believers are equipped with spiritual authority.
 - “Finally, my brethren, be strong in The LORD, and in the power of His might” (Ephesians 6:10).
 - Spiritual battles require spiritual weapons.
 - Brother Copeland taught that believers must go into battle fully armed.
 - “For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities” (Ephesians 6:12).
 - Daniel 10 records how Daniel prayed and fasted for understanding.
 - The angel told Daniel, “From the first day...thy words were heard” (Daniel 10:12).
 - Spiritual opposition attempted to delay the answer for 21 days.
 - Words of Faith release spiritual movement.

- II. Faith must be released through sound.
 - Phil Driscoll explained that thoughts alone do not shift atmospheres.
 - Intentions alone do not change outcomes.
 - Faith must be released through sound.
 - “Make a joyful noise unto The LORD” (Psalm 100:1).
 - Praise becomes a propelling force that carries believers into joy and victory.
 - Phil declared: “Dead men don’t shout. Neither do dead Christians.”
 - Quiet fear-filled believers are often losing spiritual battles because they are not releasing Faith.
 - The shout comes from the Greater One living inside the believer.
 - God responds to sounds made in His honor.

- III. The devil still uses sounds in the atmosphere to control through deception.
 - Phil explained that Lucifer learned atmosphere control in heaven before his fall.
 - “I beheld satan as lightning fall from heaven” (Luke 10:18).
 - After his fall, satan began using sounds to control the atmosphere on earth.
 - Music can influence emotions, thinking and environments.
 - Brother Copeland explained that movies use background music to create an emotional atmosphere.
 - The devil used deception in the Garden of Eden by making sin appear peaceful and desirable.
 - The tempter lied and told Eve, “Ye shall not surely die” (Genesis 3:4).

- The enemy still works through deceptive thoughts, emotions and atmosphere.
- Believers overcome by staying filled with God’s WORD and releasing praise.

Make It Personal

Every believer faces spiritual battles, but God has not left you defenseless. You are armed with the Name of Jesus, The WORD of God and the sound of Faith.

Dress yourself in your spiritual armor (Ephesians 6:1-18) and prepare to win the battle.

Declare this today:

“I am strong in The LORD and in the power of His might. I refuse fear and doubt. I release praise, Faith and thanksgiving. God is fighting for me, and I walk in victory through Jesus Christ.”

Now, write down your own declaration of your strength in The LORD Jesus.

Day 4: Casting Down Imaginations Through the Sound of Faith

What should you do when fear and negative thoughts try to take over? On this episode of *Believer's Voice of Victory*, Kenneth Copeland and Phil Driscoll explain how to cast down wrong thinking and replace it with faith-filled truth. Through powerful testimonies and biblical teaching, they show how praise and worship help believers overcome pressure and walk in peace. Tune in to this encouraging message about the sound of faith! Watch and begin renewing your mind with God's WORD today.

Study It

- I. Believers must discipline their thought life.
 - Kenneth Copeland Ministries expanded from radio into television ministry.
 - At one point, the ministry was \$6 million in debt.
 - The LORD instructed Brother Copeland to cast the care onto Jesus.
 - “Casting all your care upon Him; for He careth for you” (1 Peter 5:7).
 - Brother Copeland determined not to allow fear and pressure into his thought life.
 - “For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal” (2 Corinthians 10:4).
 - Faith-filled thinking is essential for walking in victory.

- II. Imaginations must be taken captive.
 - Phil Driscoll shares how God spoke to him while reading 2 Corinthians 10.
 - “Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God” (2 Corinthians 10:5).
 - Build a prison in your mind and put all thoughts that are against God into captivity.
 - Believers have authority to imprison thoughts that oppose God's WORD.
 - The knowledge of God declares:
 - We cannot lose.
 - We are born to win.
 - God's WORD is greater.
 - All things are possible.
 - Wrong thoughts are the primary battlefield of the enemy.
 - Thoughts that oppose God's promises must be rejected immediately.

- III. God's WORD and praise release healing and hope.
 - Phil shares about his wife Darlene's healing testimony.
 - In 1986 she was diagnosed with a breast mass and severe symptoms.
 - The LORD spoke to her, *Because you have continued in My WORD, as of this day you are healed.*
 - She boldly proclaimed her healing and received complete restoration.
 - During COVID, Phil was hospitalized with serious lung complications.
 - Brother Copeland received a word from The LORD declaring Phil healed.
 - Within days Phil regained strength and breathing capacity.
 - God had a plan and fulfilled His WORD.

- IV. Worship and The WORD strengthen believers.
- Worship and preaching God's WORD influence the atmosphere.
 - Music and preaching together help believers receive The WORD more deeply.
 - Feelings should never govern believers.
 - The WORD of God must remain the final authority.

Make It Personal

The enemy wants to control your thoughts, but God has given you authority over your mind. You can reject fear, anxiety and hopelessness through believing and speaking The WORD of God.

Thoughts cannot be removed with thoughts; they can only be removed by words. When thoughts come of failure and defeat, speak God's WORD.

Second Corinthians 10:4-5 contain your instructions. Repeat them to remove thoughts that are against The WORD of God. Believe it as if it were written directly to you.

Say this out loud:

For the weapons of my warfare are not carnal (of this world) but mighty in God: I pull down strongholds. I cast down arguments. I cast down every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God. I bring every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ. Through Christ, I win!

Day 5: Faith, Covenant and the Sound of Faith

Can covenant faith change the way you approach life's challenges? On this episode of *Believer's Voice of Victory*, Kenneth Copeland and Phil Driscoll explore God's promises through the life of Abraham; and share how the sound of faith unlocks victory and purpose. Phil's testimony and Kenneth's teaching will inspire you to boldly speak God's promises over your life. Watch now and finish the week empowered to walk by faith and not by fear.

Study It

- I. Covenant established Abraham's relationship with God.
 - Romans 4 reveals Abraham's covenant Faith.
 - The word *Covenant* in Scripture involved blood.
 - The blood of animals pointed toward the Blood of Jesus.
 - Abraham obeyed God through circumcision.
 - "And he believed in The LORD; and He counted it to him for righteousness" (Genesis 15:6).
 - Abraham was willing to offer Isaac in obedience to God.
 - "By Faith Abraham, when he was tried, offered up Isaac" (Hebrews 11:17).
 - Abraham declared, "I and the lad will go yonder and worship, and come again to you" (Genesis 22:5).
 - Brother Copeland explained that God and Abraham were Covenant partners.
 - Abraham's willingness to offer Isaac obligated God to offer His Son, Jesus.

- II. God has a purpose and a plan for every life.
 - Phil shared how empty success without God had become.
 - God knows the plans He has for every believer.
 - "For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says The LORD, thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope" (Jeremiah 29:11, NKJV).
 - Faith in God will impact the community and expand ministry opportunities.
 - Christian films and media continue to be avenues that are opening doors for the gospel.

- III. Believers must build their lives around God's presence.
 - Be cautious about limiting opportunities for believers to gather.
 - Churches should not shape their ministry around modern culture.
 - Churches must be built around God's WORD.
 - Believers need the atmosphere of Faith and God's presence.
 - "And let us consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works: Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together" (Hebrews 10:24-25).
 - Praise, worship and time in God's presence strengthen believers spiritually.

- IV. America's freedom should be remembered with thanksgiving.
 - Brother Copeland reflected on Independence Day and his military service.
 - Taking the oath while serving in the United States Army made a huge impact on his life.

- Phil Driscoll ministered “America the Beautiful” and “Taps” on the trumpet.
- Brother Copeland gave thanks to God for His goodness and Faithfulness.
